The Physician Assistant curriculum is very demanding and requires a solid academic foundation. Below you will find information related to prerequisite coursework requirements.¹

- All **prerequisite coursework** must be completed with a grade of **"C"** or better. Multiple "C" grades may make your application non-competitive.
- All **prerequisite coursework** must have been completed **within ten (10) years** before matriculation. Older coursework is *not* acceptable and *must* be repeated.
- Many colleges offer different levels of courses. The only acceptable courses are those designated for science or allied health majors. Science coursework designated for non-science majors is not acceptable.
- Coursework must be taken at a regionally accredited institution of higher learning in the United States (US). Advanced Placement (AP) credits *cannot* substitute for prerequisite courses that are required for admission.
- Online coursework is often acceptable, but it must be taken at a US accredited institution.
- Students with incomplete prerequisite courses may apply; however, there may be a delay in the application review process if two (2) or more prerequisite courses are pending.
- Applicants must complete all prerequisite courses and baccalaureate degree by June 1st.

All required documents (e.g., test scores, healthcare experience hours, and application fee) must be submitted by December 15th

^{2*} The preferred courses will count towards the prerequisite GPA calculation. Acceptable courses will be considered only if the preferred courses received AP credits or are not available at the applicant's university.
