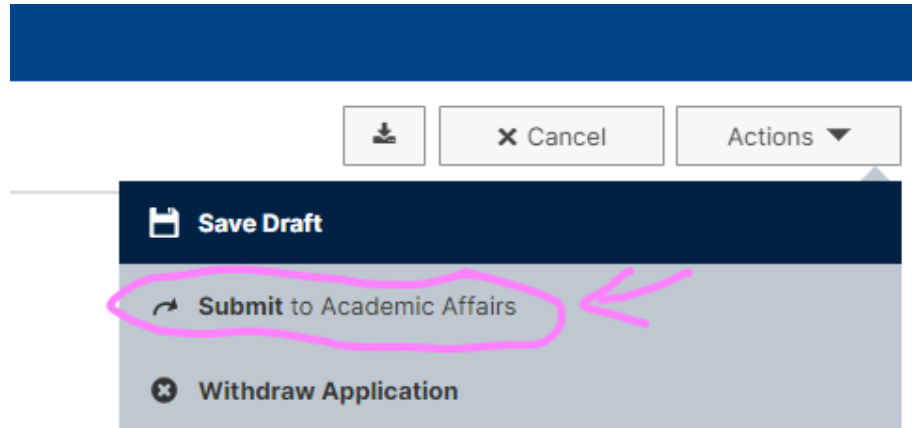
Saving your application

- Saved applications will NOT be automatically submitted!



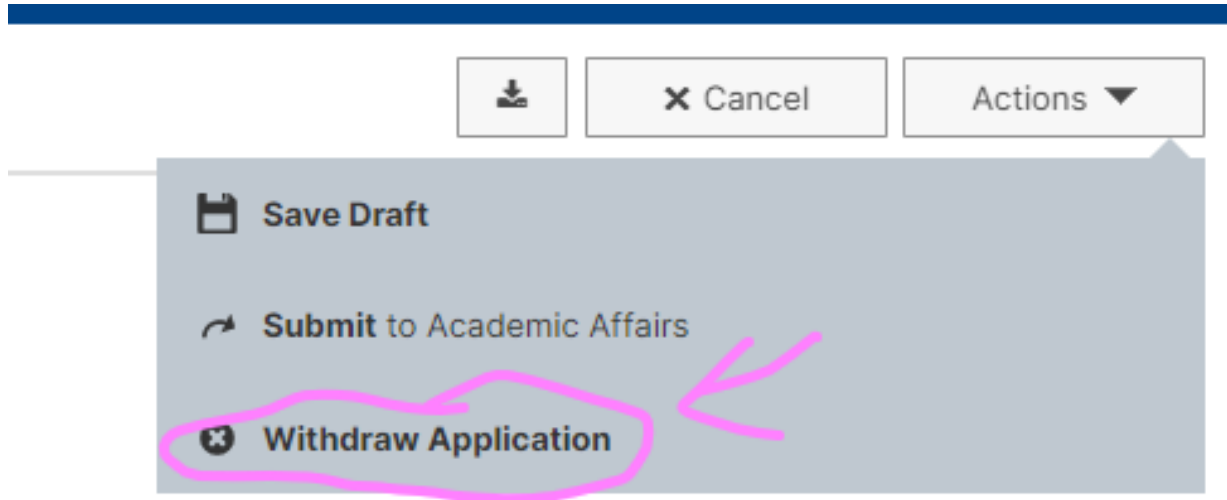
Submitting your application (cont.)

- Please remember that you cannot undo this step!



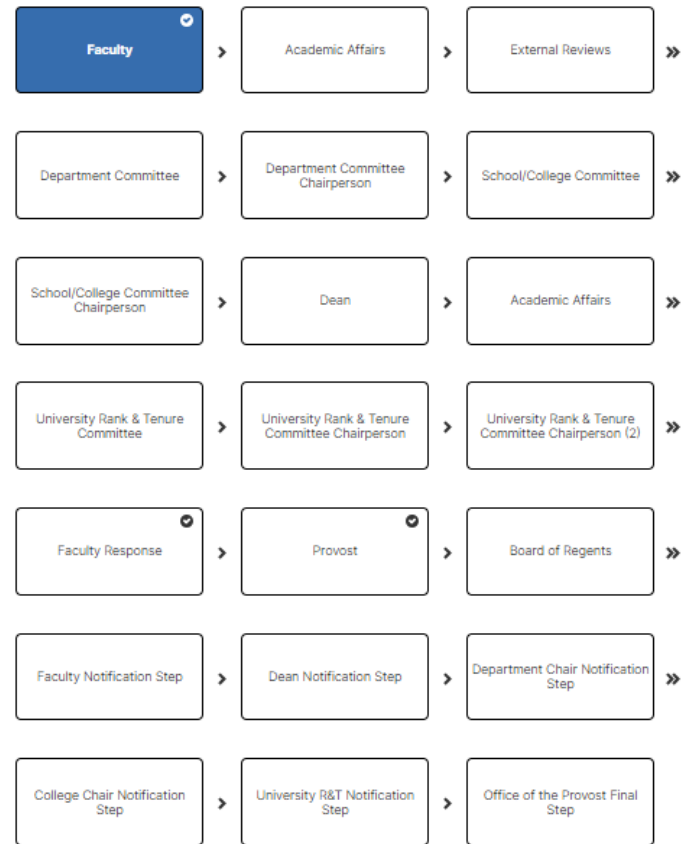

2 Academic Affairs Step

- Once the candidate submits the application, it cannot be edited (unless "Recalled"). On **October 2nd** Academic Affairs will release all applications at the same time to the next step: External Reviews
- **Deadline: October 2nd**



ATTENTION Department Committee Chairperson



- The next three steps (Step 3, 4 and 5), all require **action/submission** from the **department (committee) chairperson**.
- Please give yourself ample time to complete each step (the steps must be submitted sequentially):
 - External Review (**STEP 3**) - submit reviews ASAP because faculty cannot review until they are uploaded
 - Committee Voting process (**STEP 4**) - by Nov 1st
 - Department Statement, assessment, and member feedback and votes (**STEP 5**) - by November 2nd

- If letters were not solicited, that needs to be noted and submitted to the next step.

- Once all the letters are uploaded (if applicable) and the mandatory field selected, the department chairperson needs to click on **“Actions,”** then from the drop-down menu click on **“Submit to Department Committee.”**
- Once the application is submitted correctly it will disappear from your FS "Inbox."
- Please make sure you submit external review as soon as possible because the application will not be released from this step until you do so. Faculty colleagues will not have access to the application until you upload the letters!
- **Deadline: AS EARLY IN OCTOBER AS POSSIBLE but no later than October 15th.**

File Organization Tips

1. Always save your documents to the cloud ([Microsoft OneDrive for Business](#)) for safe keeping.
 - a. If you are not saving to a cloud storage location, backup your files regularly to an external device (USB, external hard drive, etc)
2. It is not necessary to save every file that is sent to you.
 - a. Only save files that are relevant or important to your work.
3. Group and organize your files within folders.
 - a. You may name your folders based on year, semester, location, or topic.
4. Keep track and delete any old files or previous versions you may not be using.
 - a. It is recommended to keep the original version of a document, and the final edited version of it.
5. Make digital copies of all paper documents and keep them organized in Microsoft OneDrive for Business

This will eliminate the possibility of losing a paper document.

Naming Convention Tips

File names are an important part of organizing, sharing, and tracking your data files. Developing a proper naming convention will help you save time when searching for files, as well as keep you organized for years to come.

1. Keep file names short, but descriptive.
 2. The goal when naming files is to be able to tell what the file is about without having to open it.
 3. Create relevant folders with logical names.
 4. Be consistent when naming your files.
 - a. Consider date, location, or project name to start off your file names.
 5. An example of an ambiguous file name is **DC2022July4**.
Instead, name it **2022 – Washington DC Trip**
- When naming files, ask yourself “Would this name make sense to someone else?”

Converting a Microsoft365 document to PDF format (Word or PowerPoint)

1. Click on the File menu at the top left of the screen and select **Save as** or **Save a copy**.
2. Select a location to save to file to.
3. On the right side of the screen, name your file appropriately.
4. Directly underneath the file name you have chosen, change the type of file by clicking on the drop-down menu and selecting **PDF (.pdf)**.
5. Click on the **Save** button next to the drop-down menu to save your file as a PDF.

Combining multiple PDF file

With Foxit PDF Editor, you can easily combine multiple PDF files into one convenient document and rearrange them into a particular order. To do so:

1. Open Foxit PDF Editor and click on the **Convert** tab in the top toolbar.
2. Locate and click on the **Combine Files** icon.
3. Add files by dragging and dropping them on this screen or select them individually by clicking on **Add Files**.
4. You can now decide how many pages of each document to include, and in which order you would like the combined document to be designed.
5. To complete the process, click on the **Combine** button at the top right of the screen.
6. Make sure to save this new merged document.

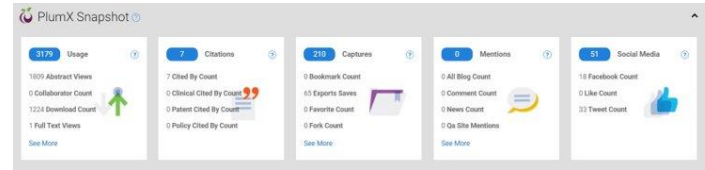

Provide Context about your Scholarship

- The Scholarly Metrics reports are meant to be a launching pad to provide context about your scholarship
- The University Rank and Tenure Committee is comprised of faculty from many disciplines – STEM vs. Non-STEM, clear Scopus presence vs. Minimal Scopus presence. Therefore, give context about your scholarship ***within your own discipline*** and ***explain the impact of your scholarship to those in other disciplines.***
- All disciplines have different benchmarks. It is important to spend time thinking about how you can contextualize your scholarship.

Provide Clarity and Context



Give explanation about solo authorship or name placement in articles with a series of authors within the context of your discipline



Open access vs. Paywall: Journals tend to be open access in Europe; therefore access is free and readership or citations may be higher than journal articles behind a paywall. Subscription based journals may have less access and therefore lower readership or citations.



Disciplines such as law or often diplomacy do not have impact factors. Be sure to explain this to your review committee.



Popular publications (Time, Vanity Fair) have wide distribution but no traditional scholarly metrics. Use web and magazine circulation and social media instead.




Describe grants applied for and grants won. How does this advance your research agenda and enhance departmental and university recognition.
